About The Organization

Habitat for Humanity is a 38 year old association present in most provinces across Canada. The goal of Habitat for Humanity is to provide access to safe, decent and affordable homeownership to families in need. Across Canada and abroad, over 3 million people have benefited from this program. An integral way in which Habitat can achieve this goal is through the ReStore Program. A Canadian initiative, ReStore is celebrating its 24th year in Canada. Currently there are over 80 ReStores across Canada.

ReStore Mississauga, which opened in March 2012, is a retail store that accepts donations and resells quality new and used building and home renovation materials and home decor. The ReStore funds generated, support Habitat for Humanity Mississauga to build more homes in our community. ReStores divert more than 20,000 tons of waste from landfills every year.

Primary Function

Responsible for the efficient pickup of donated materials to the ReStore and deliveries of sold items to customer homes. This support allows HFH Mississauga to raise funds to cover the affiliate's operational costs and build homes in the Mississauga community.

Position Duties

- Drive the ReStore 5 tonne cube van in a safe manner, obeying all rules of the road
- Assist with loading and unloading of merchandise from donor locations to ReStore receiving dock
- Assist with loading and unloading of sold merchandise from the ReStore to customer homes
- Assist with moving merchandise onto the sales floor
- Assist with training of new Volunteer Driver Assistants and Drivers when required
- Document and verify items picked up

- Ability to lift heavy items (minimum 50 lbs) in all weather conditions
- Determining the acceptability of donated product, based on ReStore Mississauga's guidelines.
- Responding to donor inquiries about Habitat for Humanity Mississauga's and the ReStore's Mission.
- Resolve and report issues and concerns as they arise
- Other duties as required

Required Qualifications and Skills

- Understanding of the Habitat for Humanity philosophy and the desire to promote it
- Possess a valid G license with a clean driving record and driver's abstract
- Provide proof of insurance and a clear police reference check
- Sign "the Co-operators Insurance Company" consent form
- Ability to work with a team or independently
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills and ability to effectively communicate with customers, donors and HFH Mississauga staff members and volunteers
- Friendly and reliable
- Access to email is an asset
- Ability to lift and unload heavy items (minimum 50 lbs)

Preferred Qualifications and Skills

- 3 years previous related job experience
- Minimum 25 years of age and older

Orientation and Training

Attend Affiliate Information Session, General ReStore Orientation and perform two shadow training shifts.

Working Conditions

All Warehouse Volunteers must wear CSA footwear. These shoes can either be provided at time of your shift or you can bring your own.
